6. Matters arising from the minutes
 - 6.1 Village Plan – update from Cllr Wroth spoke to Mr King and he’s spoken to Sam Sandell. She possibly has 3 people that would help put it together. Mr King trying to access the online document but due to the size this is causing problems. Carried to next month for an update
 - 6.2 Hedge around grazing area – discussion on cutting the overgrown trees. Conifers planted around old bowling green and these have not been cut and now over 30ft tall. It was agreed that the trees need to be cut down to 6ft. Quotes to be requested for the cutting down and removal of the trees.
 - 6.3 Pound Signs –Mr Todd spoke to a shop in fakenham and they do cast iron plaques and also do a laminate type sign which could be screwed to the wall or the door. Mr Todd to get samples and bring to show the Parish Council for futher decision to be made
 - 6.4 SAM2/Static Machines – The Parish Council decided that the they would buy a SAM2 machine and recording box which to start with would alternate between Brancaster Road and Stanhoe Road. Clerk to look into purchasing the machines. The Parish Council agreed that the CIL payments which they have received will fund the machine.
